## **IMPROVING ENVIRONMENT**

The Erie Downtown Partnership has a pronounced approach to improving the environment by leveraging clean and green services, hospitality and safety approaches, and public space improvement planning. Our Safety + Hospitality Ambassador team provides so much more than general cleaning services by working to elevate the standard of care in the public realm.

Partnerships important to this work include training from Erie HOME Team members and City of Erie Police Department on safety and interactions with vulnerable individuals. We also partner with the City of Erie, Erie Parking Authority, and Erie Port Authority to collaborate on cleaning needs, particularly during the Summer events season.

## **IMPROVING EVENTS**

Community events and the activation of public space continue to be a vital tool for economic development in Downtown Erie. As we've seen enormous growth in our small business sector, dozens of new residential units, and environmental improvements such as streetscaping, we've also seen growth in the number of attendees to both our events and other events hosted in Downtown Erie.

Critically, we've seen several new businesses and groups show interest in hosting new events themselves, from street markets and sidewalk sales to multiple new live music series in Downtown. Erie Downtown Partnership continues to refine our events calendar as well as build our capacity to help guide and assist others in their activation of Downtown Erie's public spaces. We're seeing the economic benefit of multiple new options for shopping, events, entertainment, food, and nightlife within the Downtown district, underscoring the importance of collaborating and amplifying the efforts of others.

With critical mass built around these new developments, our activation, and the efforts of others, Downtown has steadily become a more desirable place to gather and build community since the end of the pandemic.



## IMPROVING ECONOMIC VIBRANCY

Providing new opportunities for growth and inclusion in the entrepreneurial landscape is an important aspect of our work. The Erie Downtown Partnership launched a new digital gift card program to allow small businesses in the Downtown Improvement District footprint to actively manage gift card promotions as well as easily accept gift card transactions.

We also partnered with Erie Insurance on a special gift card program for their employees that resulted in downtown businesses being supported over the summer months.

Participation in events such as Small Business Saturday help emphasize Downtown as a destination for shopping and dining. Small Business Saturday saw the largest participation from both businesses and customers to kickoff the holiday season.

Key partnerships that support the small business community include our collaboration on digital gift cards through Yiftee, Erie Community Foundation, Erie Parking Authority, Erie Downtown Development Corporation, Erie Metropolitan Transportation Authority, Erie Insurance, and the City of Erie.




## **IMPROVING CAPACITY**

Like many small non-profits, capacity is always a challenge. With our growth in mind, we welcomed the organization's first development director who has helped us establish our donor infrastructure. Donor relationships flourished as we implemented a successful Erie Gives campaign as well as worked with our Development Committee to plan our new Downtown Future Fund. These contributions support the hands-on work our team does to improve the Downtown experience.

Christine Eddy assumed the role of development director at the Erie Downtown Partnership midway through the year. Prior to her arrival, the organization had not engaged in any fundraising activities. Reflecting on the progress made in 2023, the Erie Downtown Partnership has made significant strides in forging valuable partnerships through individual donations and sponsorships. In the same year, the partnership successfully enlisted 92 new donors, resulting in a total of \$31,418.

Additionally, through the remainder of the year, we established partnerships with ten new event sponsors, securing a total of \$56,650 in new funding toward our \$1.2 million budget.

With heartfelt gratitude, we thank all our donors and sponsors who generously supported us in 2023. Your unwavering support fuels our efforts, and we eagerly anticipate the opportunities that lie ahead in the future.



## Whats EXT

In 2024, we celebrate 20 years of partnerships! And those partnerships continue as we work with our members and stakeholders to reimagine a new Downtown experience.

We're launching our new annual fund titled the Downtown Future Fund and have already secured a generous lead investment. The fund is part of our capacity building strategy as we grow our programming.

We will be partnering on exciting projects including the development of our public space plan in collaboration with the City of Erie. We will be working with urban planning firm Smith Group on plan facilitation and community engagement, which will kickoff in the Summer of 2024. The project will focus on three areas to build an active network of walkable, vibrant spaces and includes Perry Square, Griswold Park, and a soon-to-be-determined third space. The plan will be completed by late Summer and will include community engagement archives, plan priorities and implementation strategy, budgets for each space, programming strategy, as well as visual design renderings of each space as imagined by the community.

As we reimagine the Downtown experience with the community, we're also reimagining the Erie Downtown Partnership brand to better communicate the place we serve and the work we do.

And we're working as an event incubator to champion better quality events and community outcomes. As a placemaking organization we are providing technical assistance and support to empower others to create better events and use of public space.

The future starts Downtown and everything you do as a collective is proof of that!
